Something in the chewing gum exploded and ripped off the lower part of his face. Reporters said: "A loud pop was heard from the student's room." Doctors checked the gum and found a strange chemical on it. The student's friends said he liked dipping gum into citric acid before eating it. The police think he made a mistake and dipped it into the wrong chemical.
