The price of staple food will more than double over the next twenty years. This is what the charity Oxfam says in its new report 'Growing a Better Future'. Oxfam warns that urgent action is needed to change world agriculture. It says hundreds of millions of people could face hunger. The charity says that by 2030, the cost of key crops will increase by 120 to 180 per cent. It adds that to make things worse, demand for food will rise by 70 per cent over the next four decades.

Oxfam says climate change is one reason for rising food prices. However, it also blames rich countries. The charity criticized the United States and the European Union for producing biofuels, which means, "15 per cent of the world's maize is used to make fuel, even at times of severe food crisis". The report gives an example of the cost to humans of biofuels: "The amount of grain required to fill the petrol tank of a 4x4 vehicle with biofuel is sufficient to feed one person for a year."
