Her 17-day tour will take in five countries - Switzerland, Norway, Britain, Ireland and France. She will also finally collect the Nobel Peace Prize she won in 1991.

On Thursday, Myanmar's opposition leader will visit the U.N.'s European HQ in Switzerland. She will then fly to Oslo to accept her Nobel prize. She will then return to England, where she lived and studied in the 1970s and where her husband came from. She will make a speech to the British government and accept an honorary doctorate at Oxford University.
