A woman from Saudi Arabia has taken part in the Olympics for the first time ever. Wojdan Shaherkani, 16, became the first female Saudi Olympian when she competed in the judo competition on Friday. Shaherkani's match was over in 82 seconds but she had already made history for her country. The London 2012 Olympics is the first time every nation competing in the Games has had female athletes. The International Olympic Committee threatened to bar all Saudi athletes if the team did not include women.

The Olympics was Shaherkani's first ever official competition. She fought even though she is not close to qualifying for a black belt. She said she was scared when she stepped onto the mat. She knew the whole world was watching her. After her match, she said: "Hopefully this is the beginning of a new era." She hopes her efforts in London will mean more Saudi women will take part in future Olympics. Many people in Saudi Arabia still strongly oppose women competing at the Olympics because they say it is un-Islamic.
