The study is from the Institute for Ocean Conservation Science at Stony Brook University in New York. Researchers looked at the DNA of soups in 14 American cities. They found 33 different species of sharks used by various restaurants. The endangered scalloped hammerhead shark was among the species found on some menus.

Shark fin soup is a delicacy in Chinese cuisine. Many customers will pay up to \$100 for a bowl of the soup. The World Wildlife Fund (WWF) says around 73 million sharks are killed around the world every year to make shark fin soup. The university scientists warned people about what they might be eating. Researcher Dr Demian Chapman analysed the DNA of the different soups. He said: "US consumers of shark fin soup cannot be certain of what's in their soup. They could be eating a species that is in serious trouble."
